GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

1. Candidates should, in addition to their Admit Card, bring one photo identity proof in ORIGINAL with clear photograph (e.g. AADHAR Card, Driving License, University/College ID, Voter ID Card, PAN Card, etc.)
2. Candidate should not be in possession of or using any mobile phone (even in switched off mode), pager or any electronic equipment or programmable device or storage media like pen drive, smart watches, etc., or camera or Bluetooth devices or any other equipment or related accessories either in working or switched off mode capable of being used as a communication device during the examination. Any infringement of these instructions shall entail disciplinary action including ban from future Examinations.
3. Use of normal or simple wrist watches by candidates is allowed inside the Examination Rooms/ Halls. However, use of watches fitted with any special accessory that might be used as communication device or smart watches is strictly prohibited and candidates are not allowed to take such watches into the Examination Rooms/ Halls.
4. Answers other than those made by Blue/Black Ball Point Pen would not be evaluated.
5. There will be no penalty (Negative Marking) for wrong answers marked by a candidate.
6. Candidates are advised not to bring any valuables/costly items to the Examination Hall, as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured. The Authority will not be responsible for any loss in this regard.
7. Candidates should note that any omission/ mistake/ discrepancy in encoding / filling in details in the OMR answer sheet, especially with regard to Roll Number and Test Booklet Series Code, will render the answer sheet liable for rejection.
8. Wearing of mask/face cover is mandatory for all candidates. Candidates without mask/face cover will not be allowed entry into the Venue.
